### **IMPORTANT REMINDERS REGARDING YOUR CHILD'S HEALTH**

\*All parents must provide within 30 days of enrollment, a current health appraisal, completed and signed by your child's health care provider within the last 12 months.

\*A record showing proof of current immunizations must also be provided to the school before attending school.

\*Students will NOT be able to remain in preschool without a current health appraisal and immunization record.

\*All APS students have access to the "Kids Clinics" that are located on site at Laredo & Crawford Elem. (You can call 720-837-4761 to schedule an appointment.)
